994 Babys were born in the Zuger Kantonsspital in 2020

This time, boys outnumbered girls: 508 boys and 486 girls were born. The two months with the highest birth rates were March with 106 babies and July with 107 babies.

The team at the Women's clinic is very pleased that it was once again able to accompany so many parents at the birth of their child last year. "This is a great sign of trust and appreciation for our clinic and our obstetrics team", says head physician Christoph M. Honegger, and goes on to say that "the personal support and care of mother and child is central to us - I am glad that I can count on a very committed and flexible team".
